

# Consulting Electrical Engineers **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

## CRITERIA AND ELIGIBILITY

**TWO Scholarships will be awarded for the  
2019-2020 calendar year with a value of \$1,000 each.**

### **Who is eligible?**

The children, step children and grandchildren of all CEE Members in good standing. Good Standing is defined as dues are paid in full for the current season. CEE members themselves may also apply for this award if they are enrolled in an accredited four year college or university pursuing a bachelor's or advanced degree.

### **What is awarded?**

A minimum \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in an undergraduate or master's program at an accredited four year college or university. The scholarships will be made payable directly to the institution of learning upon receipt of a tuition statement.

### **How to apply?**

Complete the CEE scholarship application (available at [www.eachicago.org/education](http://www.eachicago.org/education) or [www.eachicago.org/divisions](http://www.eachicago.org/divisions) on the CEE page) and have the CEE referring member and appropriate school official complete their respective sections of the application form. Attach all required documents according to the checklist. **Return the application, current high school or college transcripts, recommendation letters and goal aspiration essay to the Electric Association Education Foundation office no later than April 19th.**

### **How are the scholarships awarded?**

A selection committee will review all of the applications (applicant and CEE members' names will be omitted from the materials that are presented to the selection committee). The Scholarship will be awarded to the chosen recipient at the CEE Annual Technical Forum at the Union League Club of Chicago in May.

Successful applicants will be selected based on;

- past educational performance
- leadership and participation in school and community activities
- continued educational and career goals and aspirations
- recommendations by instructors / advisors

**CEE Scholarship:** This scholarship is open to all fields of study, but the CEE Scholarship Committee may give special attention to those seeking a degree in electrical engineering.

**Gerry Ryan CEE Scholarship:** This scholarship, named in honor of Gerry Ryan, is open to all fields of study, but the CEE Scholarship Committee will give special attention to a woman student seeking a degree in electrical engineering or STEM.
